

# Setting Up Web Feed – Macs

## PURPOSE

How to set up web feed and Cloud shortcuts to access your files & applications on a Mac computer. These instructions are for Pro Plus / Premier / Enterprise users.

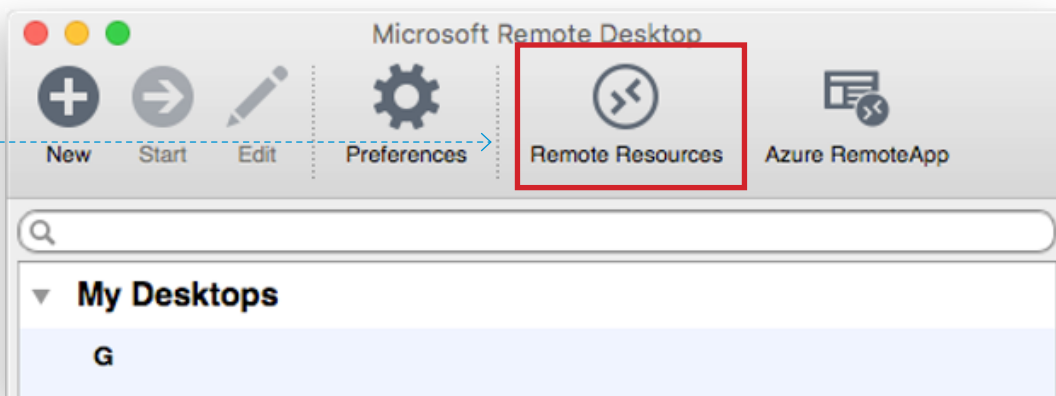
### STEP 1

Open the Microsoft Remote Desktop application.



### STEP 2


Click Remote Resources.



**STEP 3**

Complete the fields in the Remote Resources window:


- **URL:** “https://vm-xxxx.cloud9realtime.com/rdweb/feed/webfeed.aspx” (replacing “vm-xxxx” with your private server number)
- **User Name:** Type “Cloud9\” followed by your user name
- **Password:** Type your password

Click **Refresh**.

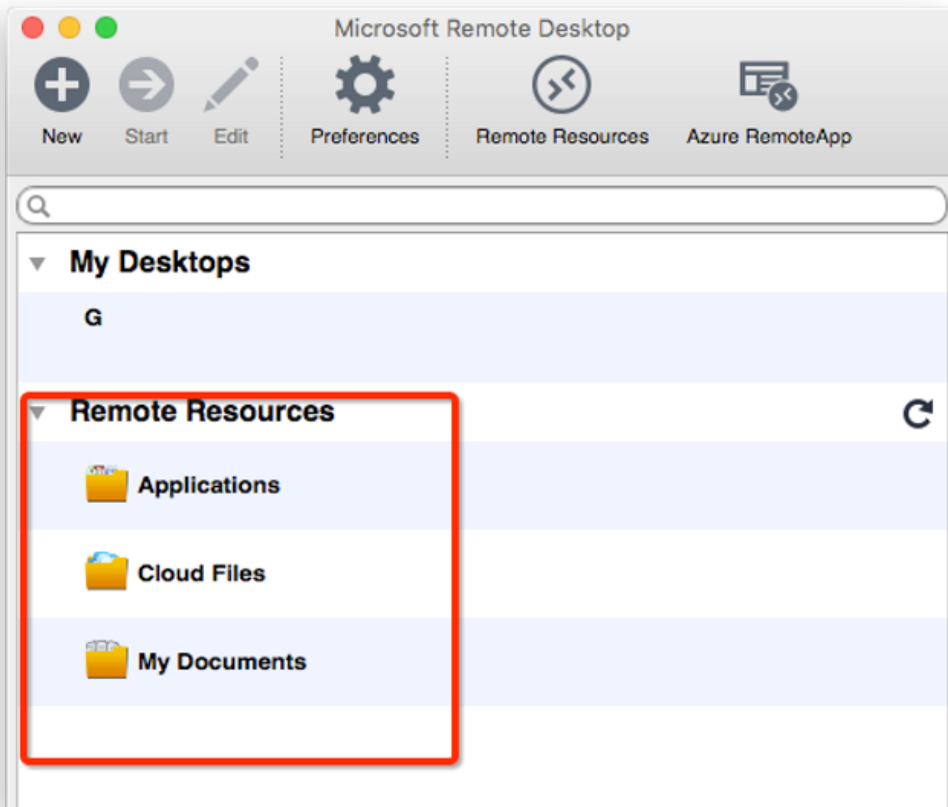
